Power Related

- Subsidy on power tariff will be provided at the rates of thirty percent and twenty
 five percent for loads up to 2 MW and loads above 2 MW respectively for a period of
 five years from the date of commercial production. The subsidy will be limited to a
 maximum of Rupees 2 lakhs annually. This subsidy will be granted on the basis of
 actual consumption of power for the manufacturing process substantiated with
 requisite details and diagrams.
- Subsidy up to fifty percent of the cost of generating sets including non-conventional energy generating sets, subject to a ceiling of Rs. 50,000/- per unit, will be granted to SSI units in the non-electrified rural areas provided the unit produces a certificate from Meghalaya State Electricity Board to this effect.
- In case a project is located in an areas which requires the drawal of the power line of 11 KV and above, then the Government will reimburse the cost incurred on the drawal of such a power line including the cost of transformers, if any, subject to a maximum limit of Rupees one lakh and provided that the location has been approved by the Government.
- Fifty percent of the cost incurred on service connection will be reimbursed subject to a maximum of Rs. 20,000/- for each industrial unit.
