

MSME community's contribution towards Uttarakhand relief



As you are aware, India's hill state Uttarakhand has been devastated by a natural calamity of unimaginable proportions in June 2013. Thousands of human habitats, roads and bridges have been washed away in the large parts of Garhwal region of the state resulting in enormous human and material loss.
